The Aquatic Science Adventure Camp 2005

Join our environmental educators for a fun-filled week of hands-on science in the outdoors, studying the ecology of lakes, creeks and the San Francisco Bay.

Children age 5 – 7 will enjoy fishing for crabs, catching crayfish, studying damselfly nymphs, experimenting with estuary water, plant art, nature hikes, games and more in the watery Berkeley habitats of Lake Anza, Jewel Lake, Strawberry Creek and the Marina.

Children age 8 – 10 will take a boat trip on the San Francisco Bay and study the animals and plants living in the open water, in a new partnership with the Star Duster boat. They will complete detailed investigations of bay-estuary and creek habitats and learn how to take action to help solve some of the issues affecting their local environment. Sites will include Berkeley Marina, Point Richmond Beach, Wildcat Creek and Lake Anza.
